



New Kodo Album Akatsuki On Sale January 22, 2011

It has been five years since our bestof album *Heartbeat Best of Kodo 25th Anniversary* hit the shelves and six years since our last all-original album *prism rhythm* was released. So this year we are extremely excited to put out a brand new album that captures the spirit of the group today and is sure to become a defining recording for Kodo in the next generation.

Recorded at Kodo Village, this 11-track disc includes brand new compositions as well as never-beforerecorded stage pieces. Our favorite songs, polished in performance on countless stages worldwide, have been given new life through special arrangements that are only possible in a recording setting. Some new music was composed especially for this album, while other songs were born of collaboration with other artists. A few of the tracks showcase the captivating vocals of our female performers, while all eleven highlight Kodo's broad range of expression and individuality.

Akatsuki also features a new piece, Honoka, written to commemorate legendary artist Taro Okamoto's centennial birthday. As a new release, the album comes with a Limited Edition Bonus DVD featuring behind-the-scenes footage of Kodo and Sado Island while the album was recorded.

Kodo December Concerts 2010

Thank you very much to everyone who joined us for the Kodo December Concerts last month.

Here are some photographs from the performances, to let you relive the concert or get a glimpse of what you missed. Yoshikazu Fujimoto was one of three featured O-daiko soloists in this programme, and he turned 60 on December 30th. We celebrated his special birthday with a talk & performance followed by a reception in Tokyo on December 18th. Yoshikazu is still going strong as a Kodo performer, and we look forward to your continued support.

Here are the programme notes for two pieces that were featured on stage in the December Concerts and appear on our new album *Akatsuki*:

Yoshino no Yama

(Traditional, arranged by Yoko Fujimoto) Yoshino no Yama is a song and shamisen piece that dates back to the Muromachi Period (14-16th century). This song has seen many incarnations throughout the centuries, but today it is best known through musician Harue Momoyama who turned it into a contemporary classic. Kodo performs this piece by harnessing the powerful voices of Yoko Fujimoto and Yoshie Sunahata layered over an accompaniment of taiko, gongs and bells.

Sora

(Composed by Shogo Yoshii, 2010)

This piece brings a dynamic twist to a light-hearted bamboo flute melody, adding tone and texture with taiko and cymbals. Cultivating inspiration through the people, places and diverse music that Kodo encounters on its journeys, composer Shogo Yoshii hopes the group will find new energy for expression through this piece.
